Achievements

- Developed 180 small and big lakes with the area of 3 to 30 Acres and Developed 3091 small water harvesting units or farm ponds and harvesting 3520 Million litres of water every year.
- Provided irrigation facilities to 15300 Hectares of farm land and helped 11000 farmers. Farmers are getting second crop through this irrigation.
